

# Minnegoed

## Cape Rose Family Collection Shelsy 2017

Minnegoed Wines were created specially as an ode to the Flemish family Goeminne, for its love and dedication to South Africa in general and the unique wines produced in the country in particular.

The name Minnegoed is very well chosen in the Flemish language, the word "beminnen" means to show affection and love (hence: 'Minne') and the "goed" is a double-entendre in this case: it can refer to the quality of the wine as well as the estate on which it is produced: the Dutch word "wijngoed" is "winery" in English.

The Family Collection features three types of wine. Each name refers to one of the Goeminne children, in which the Sienna range is composed of white wines, the Shelsy range includes the rose wine and the Milan range features the reds.

### The Wine

Grapes were hand picked in the early hours of the harvesting day from designated vineyard blocks. They were destemmed and crushed before undergoing a controlled cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks. The wine was stabilised, filtered and then bottled into a lightweight 350gr bottle.

### Winemaker's Comments

Serve ice cold when drinking on hot summer days! Red berry fruit characters on this wine bounce from aromas to taste flavours. Fresh strawberry and raspberry notes make for this being a solo sipping wine or well paired with small plate meals.



### The Analysis

Alcohol 12.47% | Total acidity 6.5 g/L | Residual sugar 10.9 g/L | pH 3.39
